#### SNOW AND ICE SAFETY

- We are still experiencing cold weather with snow and ice. Bins containing sand and gravel are located on the decks, by the carports and on certain sidewalks. Please use gravel on the sidewalks and parking lots and ice-melt on the decks and stairs.
- Please contact Judy Walker at Ultimate Property Management to report any slips or falls.

#### YARD CLEANUP

- Once we are officially into spring (gardening season) there will be a bag available to put your organic yard waste.

### COMPOSTING CHANGES

- The City of Calgary is now picking up our compostable items. Pet waste is now accepted but this waste, as with all organics deposited in the bins, must be securely tied in CERTIFIED COMPOSTABLE BAGS.
  - ◇ Regular dog waste bags are not accepted in the bins.
  - ◇ Loose organics may create foul odours.
- A large bag will be available specifically for yard waste in the coming months. Please save your yard waste for this collection bag.

### Odds and Ends

- The on-site garbage bins are for domestic waste only. Furniture and renovation waste are not permitted in these bins and must be disposed of elsewhere.
- Smoke detectors should be replaced every ten years.
- Carbon monoxide detectors older than 2009 should be replaced
- A reminder that the parking lot speed limit is 8 km/hr.
